Subcommittee Descriptions 2021-2022

Dissemination Subcommittee – Promotes/communicates research by the Academy's
Research International & Scientific Affairs (RISA) team, including but not limited to
Evidence Analysis Library's systematic reviews and guidelines, manuscripts, webinars, and
FNCE and other conference presentations. Collaborate with strategic communications and
other Academy teams to

facilitate dissemination of research projects and products. Track impact of dissemination efforts.

- a. May include communications, review of content and suggested methods of dissemination, and collaboration to determine opportunities for research dissemination.
- 2. **Workgroup Selection Subcommittee** Review and score applicants for workgroups that will conduct systematic reviews, develop guidelines & positions, advise Nutrition Research Network (NRN) studies, etc.
 - a. May include study advisory, systematic review and evidence-based practice guidelines, and Academy position paper workgroups
- 3. **Survey Review Subcommittee** –Review content and design of Academy, Dietetic Practice Groups (DPGs), student, and member surveys. Provide guidance on the Institutional Review Board (IRB) process and feedback on materials for IRB submission. Coordinate approvals to send out surveys to NRN members, Academy members, DPGs and Member Interest Groups (MIGs) and coordinate with CDR and marketing as necessary.
- 4. **Implementation Subcommittee** Promote and develop resources to aid in implementation of evidence-basednutrition practice guidelines (EBNPGs) and in building RDN capacity to conduct research. Collaborate and obtain input from Quality Management, Academy's Health Informatics Infrastructure, and Nutrition Care Process when applicable. May include Training Module development, webinars, and presentations relating to implementation.
- 5. **Scientific Integrity Principles Subcommittee** Work with Academy groups and committees in order to increase awareness regarding conducting research and adhering to scientific integrity principles (SIP). Group willmaintain and disseminate SIP oversight for all Academy groups.
 - a. May include resource development in multiple manners such as webinars, flowcharts/infographics, podcasts, etc.
- 6. **Regulatory Topics Subcommittee** Promote Academy's and RISA's legislative and public policy priorities by reviewing and providing comments on various research- related regulatory opportunities from the Public Policy Team. Will collaborate and communicate with Academy's Public Policy Team and relevant Academy groups.
